The Grammar Stage of Classical Education: - During the Grammar phase, children are particularly good at memorization. Young children learn songs and rhymes, and recite facts with relative ease. Each subject has its own grammar. In science, children memorize facts about the laws of physics, the bones in the body, or the planets. In math, children memorize times tables. In history, children memorize dates like in our Timeline. In Latin, teachers emphasize vocabulary. Throughout each year in the grammar stage, classically educated children learn the factual foundation of each subject. We use songs, chants, and rhymes to help children enjoy the learning experience.
