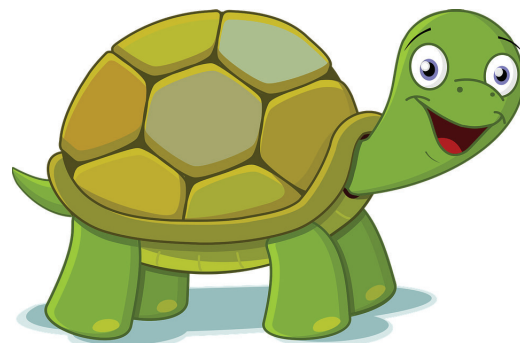
ACADEMY STUDENTS THE FISH FRY:
