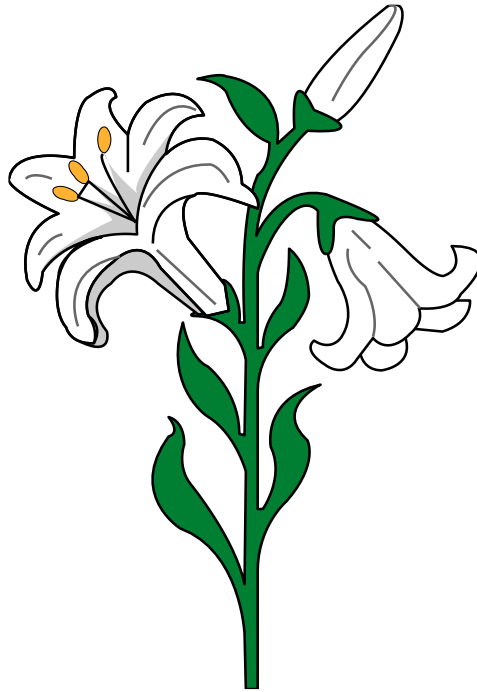


*The casket has been covered with a funeral pall, a symbol of Christ's righteousness that covers all our sin.*

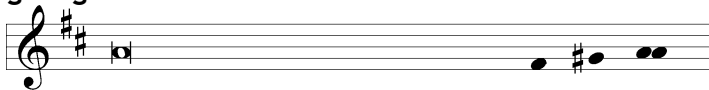

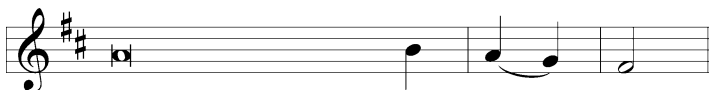

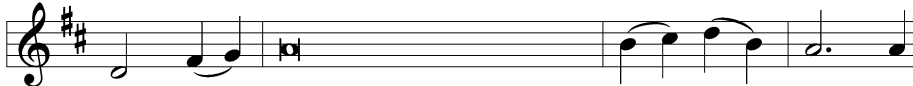
