### THEME: You are the salt of the earth!

Christians are called “the salt of the earth” and “the light of the world” because they have the Gospel of Christ’s forgiveness and believe in Him. The Gospel is like salt that preserves us from sin and death or like light that illumines the darkness of unbelief and banishes the falsehood of human self-righteousness. Christians must never let go of the Gospel. The Church must continue to preach and confess it in all its truth and purity. The Gospel is the power of God for salvation and the source of true wisdom and real truth. We are called to let the light of the Gospel shine forth in works of mercy and charity that reflect God’s undeserved love for sinners. Jesus did not come to overturn or destroy the demands of the Law, but to fulfill them by the sacrifice of Himself upon the cross. He did the Law and taught the Law in His death upon the cross. His suffering and death for sin is God’s righteousness. We receive it by faith in Him. It is the only righteousness that can save us and the only righteousness that can save the world.


